Call to Order: Meeting was called to order by Chair Dennis McVey at 6:30 pm

Roll Call: Those present were Dennis McVey, Shanna Burk, Sheryl Turner, Steve Turner.

Guests: Ken Goold, Calligraphy instructor.

Approval of Agenda: Motion for approval of July 2, 2019 meeting agenda submitted by Dennis McVey was made by; Sheryl Turner 2nd by Shana Burk and approved 4/0.

Approval of Last Meeting Minutes: McVey asked for approval of the Minutes of April 2, 2019 meeting.

Shana Burk made motion to approve; Sheryl Turner seconded; motion approved 4/0.

Reports: Chair McVey reported on current gallery materials and the security system. We have had the following donations, two 4' x 4' oil paintings by Michael Casad, a black and white sketch, and three loaned oil paintings. Information on the items is listed in the gallery inventory. In addition, Myrna Orsini and husband donated a large sculpture to the City of Rainier which will be placed on the TRY trail. Chair McVey will be receiving additional donated paintings next week.

Unfinished Business: Sheryl Turner discussed having a beginning upholstery class starting in September, details to be finalized later.

Shana Burk discussed holding family-oriented craft classes once a month in the evening, details to be determined.

MR. Ken Goold will teach a six-week calligraphy class from 7:00 PM – 8:00 PM each Wednesday beginning July 17, 2019 and running until August 28, 2019. Maximum of 12 students with a student fee of \$25.00 for class materials cost. Students will sign up for the class at Rainier City Hall on a first come first served basis, a waiting list may be made in case there is interest in an additional class.


Chair McVey will prepare a flyer about the class and get it posted throughout the city and placed on the We Love Rainier site and the city reader board.
